- **What is your interpretation of bullying?**

Feedback-all need to be consistent with what it is.

Share school acronym- STOP- What does this stand for?

- **Introduce the new initiative - Playground Friends. Weekly meetings to discuss any issues in the yard. Children to come up with initiatives on how to prevent/ stop bullying taking place.**

Any ideas for what you would like to see the 'Playground Friends' doing.

Children had to apply to be a Playground Friend and were given an informal interview.

They work on a rota basis doing duties on different days each week.

Playground Friends have red hoodies, they are easily recognisable. They organise games and befriend and look after children who seem to be on their own.

If permission given suggestion to put photographs of Playground Friends on the website.

Hopefully this will mean teachers have less issues to deal with on an afternoon

Mrs Hough pointed out children go home and tell tales about the playground
