| Year 2 | - In painting, use a variety of thick and thin brushes to produce lines and shapes, textures and patterns <br> - In painting, mix colours to make secondary colours and add white to make tints/black to make tones <br> - Use a range of pencils to draw lines of different lengths/thickness and show pattern using dots/lines <br> - In collage, mix materials to create texture eg coiling, overlapping, montage <br> - In sculpture, create and combine shapes to make recognisable shapes <br> - In textiles, weave and join materials using glue or stitch <br> - In print, use repeat and overlapping shapes (using objects to create print) <br> - Use correct artistic vocabulary <br> - Use and apply art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space with a range of materials <br> - Know about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers <br> - Describe similarities and differences and make links to own work |
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| Year 3 | - Create sketchbooks to record and revisit observations <br> - In painting, use white to make tints and black to make tones and create a colour wheel <br> - In collage, consider the effect of chosen materials and technique <br> - In sculpture, include texture that conveys feelings, expression or movement and refine use of tools <br> - In textiles, use plaiting and dip-dye techniques <br> - In print, press, roll, rub and stamp and recreate print from environment <br> - In digital media, use a range of tools to create different lines, colours, shapes, tones and textures <br> - Use range of artistic vocabulary to discuss and evaluate work <br> - Use and apply art and design techniques and improve their control and use of materials <br> - Evaluate work of some artists and analyse creative works <br> - Know about great artists, architects and designers and how their art/design reflected and shaped our history |
