Holidays in term time

Just to clarify our policy on taking holidays during term time. We follow the Stockton Borough Council guidance as there is no national statutory information. However, we have been made aware that the government intend to make this the same for all local authorities.

No holiday will be authorised. This means that an unauthorised mark will be given for the days they are absent. Holidays of 4 days and under will be unauthorised but no fine will be given.

Holidays of 5 days and over will be fined. This is £60 per parent, per child. We do appreciate that this is expensive but most parents do take children on holiday during term time as it is far cheaper. There may be exceptional circumstances for taking holiday out of term time so if you feel that this is the case, please contact the school office for guidance.

We do not receive any money in school from these fines as they are issued by the local authority.

Attendance

If your child is unwell, please could you call the office every day to let us know. It is important that we know every day that they are not coming in. Thank you for this.

<u>Covid</u>

The dreaded Covid seems to be on the rise in school and we have had a number of staff and children that have tested positive. Please be aware of this, if your child feels unwell. The advice is to stay away from people for 3 days or until they feel well.
