Year 6 Autumn Term 1

English



Our book for this half term is **Cogheart**. We will be using this fantastic text to write explanation texts, letters, diary entries, descriptions and will create our own very own mechanical animal.

Science

Our topic this half term is, **Living Things**. topic helps children identify the kingdoms of life and to classify living things within those kingdoms. The children will be introduced to the Linnaean system of classification and will be able to develop their practical scientific skills.

Computing

We will be exploring computing, the internet and communication.

Maths

We will be focussing on Place Value, addition and subtraction, multiplying and dividing as well as fractions, decimals and percentages. We will be looking at problem solving and how to apply different methods and use reasoning to solve given problems.

R.E

We will be exploring and discussing the belief of **Christianity** and asking why the gospel accounts are so different.

Geography

We will be looking at the **United Kingdom** and working towards being able to identify key geographical features. We will identify countries, cities and towns of the UK and research hills, mountains, seas and continents.

Music and Art

William Morris is our focus this half term and we will be investigating how he used nature in his designs and his use of tone, shade and colour through painting and sketching. In music we will be developing an understanding of the history of music.
