Year 6 Spring Term 1

English



Our book for this half term is **Orphans of the Tide**. We will be using this fantastic text to write, explanation texts, letters, diary entries, descriptions and flashback narratives.

Science

Our topic this half term is, **Evolution and Inheritance**. Through presentations and tasks, the children will learn about the fascinating history of the human race and discover links between extinct animals and those which are still living today.

Computing

We will be exploring **variables in games**.

Maths

We will be focussing on **fractions, decimals and percentages, converting units of measurement, ratio, algebra and statistics**

We will be learning about the **Hindu** worldview and way of life and focusing on areas such as 'what do Hindus believe God is like?' and 'what does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today?'

Geography

We will be exploring the countries, cities, landmarks, time zones and people of **North America** from the vast lands of the USA and Canada down through Central America and on to the Caribbean islands. On the way we will explore the various geographical features of different areas of North America and compare them with features of the United Kingdom

Music and Art

Our whole school art project of '**Take One Picture**', with the **National Gallery**, will focus on the Canaletto painting of 'A Regatta on the Grand Canal'. We will be perfecting our painting skills during this project. In music we will be developing an understanding of **beat, pulse, rhythm and structure**.

PSHE/P.E.

In PSHE we will be focusing on **Positive Relationships Disagreeing Respectfully, Family, Marriage and Civil Partnerships, Love and Abuse**. In P.E we will be looking at **health related fitness**.
