

# Year 3 Curriculum Coverage Spring Term 1 - 2025

## Geography:

In Geography, we will be using atlases to locate countries in Europe and America. We will then 'zoom in' and focus on the European country of 'France', and compare it to the United Kingdom. We will also be learning Geographical terms like equator, tropics, hemispheres and meridians.

## PSHE:

This half term, our PSHE unit of work is all about 'Relationships'. In this unit, we will explore different family structures, caring and supportive relationships, permission, privacy and boundaries.



## Art:

Our whole school art project of 'Take One Picture', with the National Gallery, will focus on the Canaletto painting of 'A Regatta on the Grand Canal'. We will be perfecting our painting skills during this project.

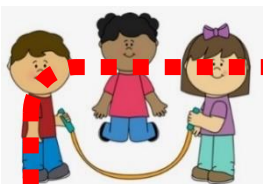
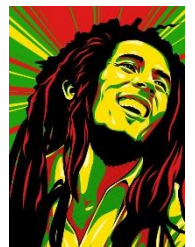
## Science:
