

Year 3 Curriculum Coverage Summer Term 2 - 2025

History:

In History, we will be continuing our topic of Ancient Egypt. We will be learning about the importance of the River Nile, the gods that they worshipped, the discovery of Tutankhamun and how the Ancient Egyptians lived their lives.

PSHE:

This half term, we will explore 'Living in the Wider World'. In this unit, we will explore jobs and skills, setting SMART goals and targets, as well as looking at career routes and qualifications.



Art:

This half term's art lessons will focus on 'sculpture'. The children will learn how to sculpt in clay.


Science:
