

Year 4 Curriculum Coverage Summer Term

Geography (Summer 1):

In Summer 1, we are learning about Europe and Asia and comparing the different continents. The children will look at where Asia is in relation to Europe. We will also look at different physical and human features of each country.

Geography (Summer 2):

In Summer 2, we will be learning about Rivers and The Water Cycle. We will investigate rivers and the different features of them. We will also look at the River Tees specifically.



Science (Whole Term):

In Summer 1, we will be focusing on sound. We will look at how sound is made and find different patterns in terms of pitch and volume. In Summer 2, we will be learning about solids, liquid and gases. The children will compare and group materials.



Art (Whole Term):

This term, we will be focusing on sculpture. Looking at what a sculpture is and studying the sculptor Anthony Gormley. We will be visiting Newby Hall for inspiration before making our own. We are also lucky to be included in an art project connected to the Darlington & Stockton railway in June..



P.E (Whole Term):

This term, Mr Fox will be working with the children to focus on striking and fielding and athletics. We will also be having a times table orienteering event that parents and carers have been invited to.

R.E (Whole Term):

This term we will be studying Hinduism focusing on the question ‘What does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today?’ After half term, we will be looking at a number of different religions and how and why people mark the significant events of life?
