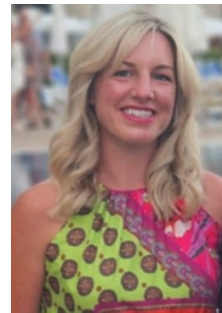

Homework

Reading: In Year Five your child will have a reading book aligned to their reading ability. The expectation is that children are reading regularly at home as well as in school

Spellings: Your child will receive a new set of spellings every Monday, and they will be tested on these the following Monday.

Maths: Your child's maths homework is to consolidate and increase the speed of their times table knowledge using Times Table Rockstars. All children should already have a log in for this, if you have any trouble logging in please contact school as soon as possible.

Reading

We are sure you'll agree, that reading is a vital part of your child's education, and at Fairfield Primary School, we believe that if both home and school work together, it can have a huge impact on reading progress and development. We expect regular reading at home, and records to be signed and commented on by an adult. Reading books will be changed weekly, or more often if required. Reading packets should be brought to school **every day**.

Communication

It is important that home and school work closely together. We will use 'SeeSaw' to send messages about your child's achievements and a weekly over-view about what your child is learning. If you do not use or have this app, please inform the office ASAP, and they will be more than happy to help you sign up for free! Being Prepared!

P.E will be taught by Mr Fox every Thursday afternoon. Your child should come to school wearing their P.E kit on the day they have P.E. Additional P.E sessions will take place on a Monday morning alternating every half term — don't worry we will remind you on SeeSaw!

A school P.E kit of black shorts/joggers and a plain white top and school jumper is required. No football kits. Also, no jewellery is allowed, earrings must be removed.
